


# 20 miles for Marie Curie



# Audrey Lewis RIP

Audrey Lewis 22<sup>nd</sup> May 1928 – 19<sup>th</sup> April 2022

On 12<sup>th</sup> May, family and friends said goodbye to Audrey Lewis who died just after Easter, following a short illness. Audrey was a much-loved member of the Christ Church family. She and Eric actively took part in services and Audrey was a regular member of Good Companions.



Audrey was born in Tredegar in May 1928. She spent her childhood in Merthyr and moved to Cardiff when she was twelve. She attended Cardiff High School for Girls. Audrey did well academically at school, but the family could not afford to send her to university. She therefore began working for Boots the Chemist training as a dispenser; her intelligence and hard work enabled her to win a Boots' scholarship to study for a pharmacy degree in London.

On returning to South Wales she met Eric, also a pharmacist. They married, had three children, six grandchildren and one great grandson and celebrated their Diamond Anniversary recently. In more recent years Audrey was always interested in learning new skills: knitting, crochet, French and Welsh, and playing the piano.
